

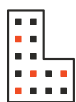

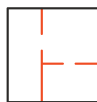

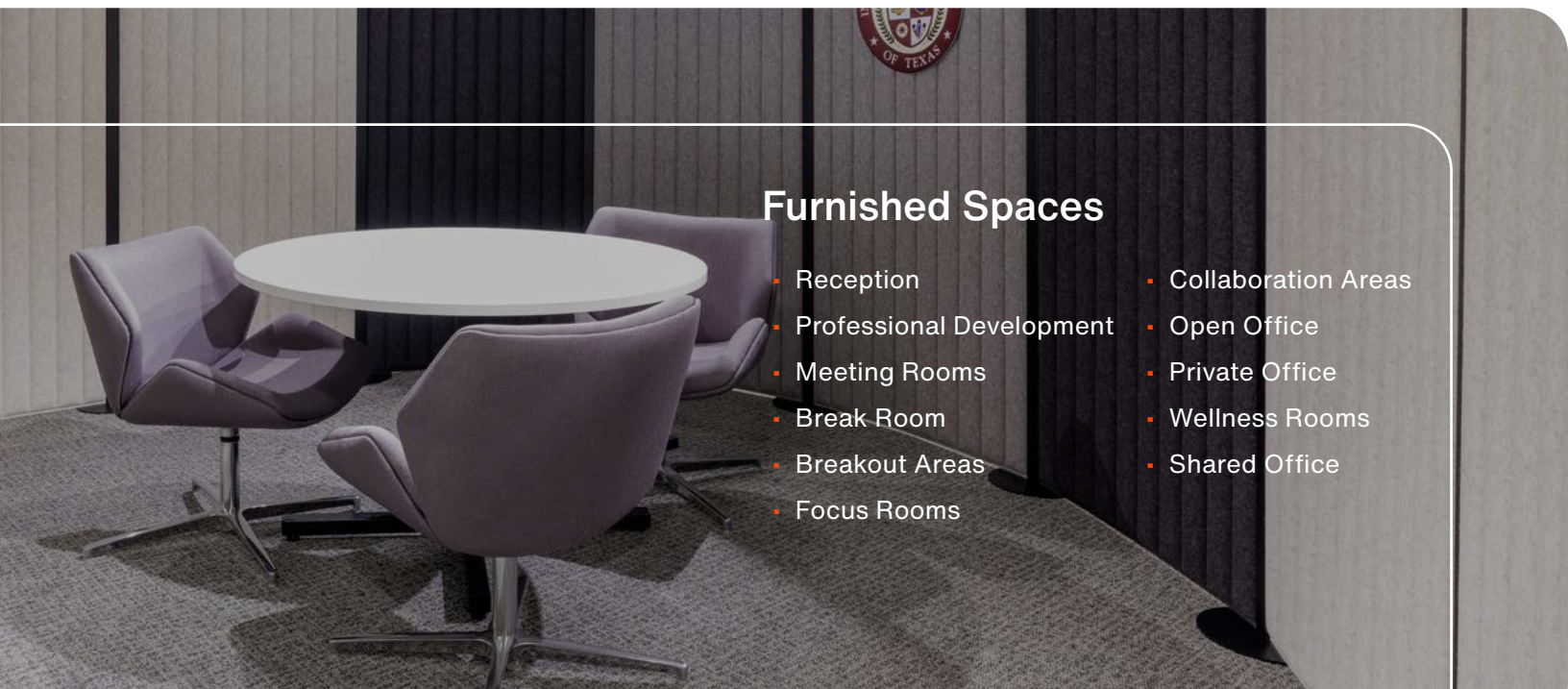
The Challenge

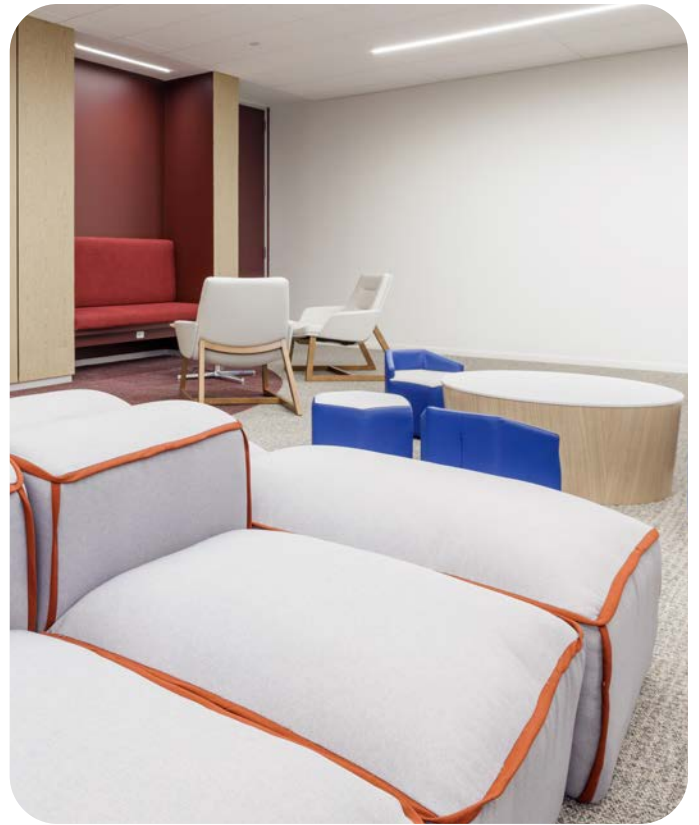


Centralizing Servant Leadership

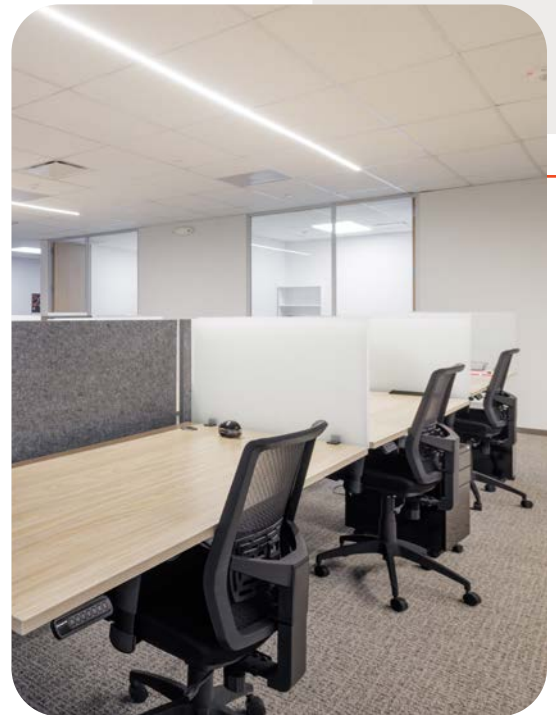
