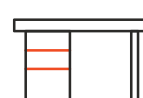

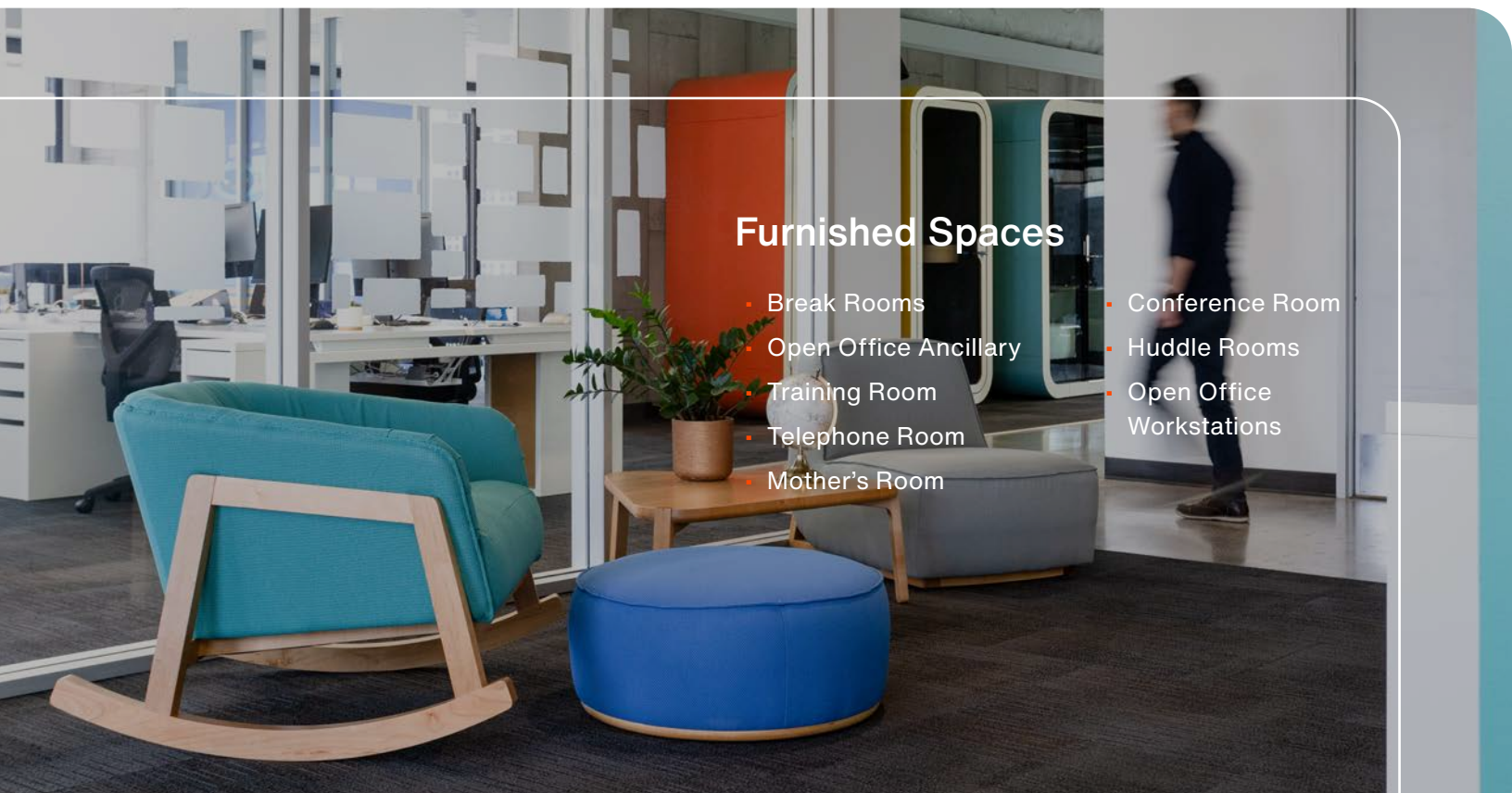
The Challenge

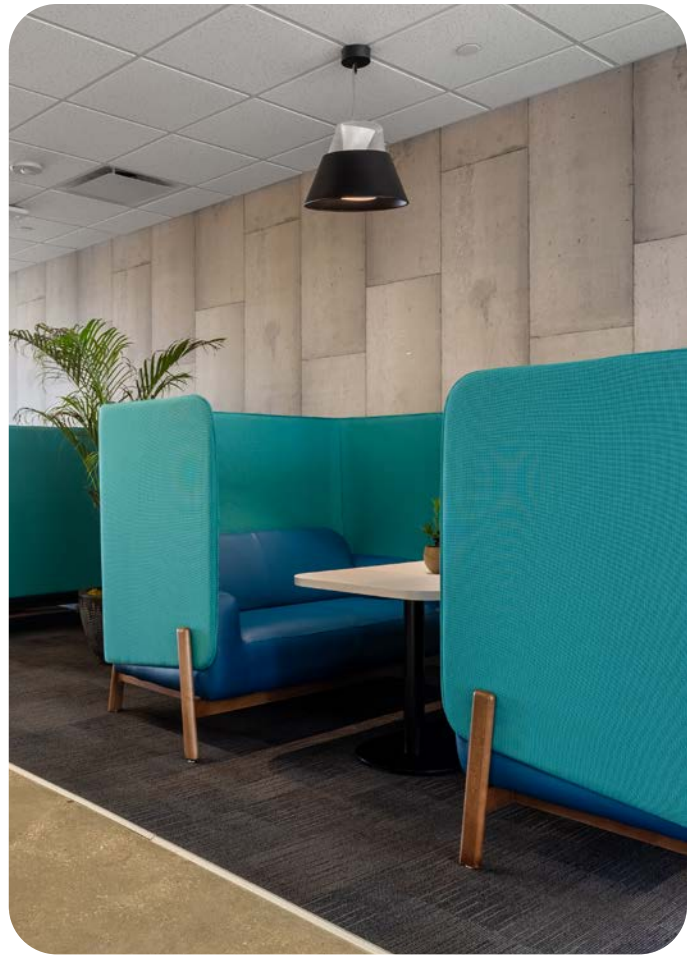


Project Summary

The LogicMonitor team partnered with CultureSpace to outfit two floors of office space acquired in downtown Austin. With floor-to-ceiling windows along the perimeter of each floor, it was important that our team strategically designed a floor plan that would allow the space to remain bright, open, welcoming and provide lots of opportunities to connect, while still creating pockets of workspaces specifically for focusing on tasks.

We maximized the floor plan using benching systems to keep the environment bright and collaborative for everyday work. Beyond each of the rows of workstations, employees can find an assortment of flexible spaces including lounge seating, huddle rooms, conference rooms, privacy pods, and other open-office ancillary seating to step away to and get work done or meet with team members.

The assortment of collaborative workspaces, bold furniture colors, and multifunctional break areas helped to create a diverse space to connect and collaborate, matches the client's fun branding, and will stand out to prospective talent in the area.
