

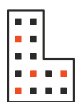

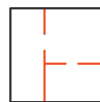

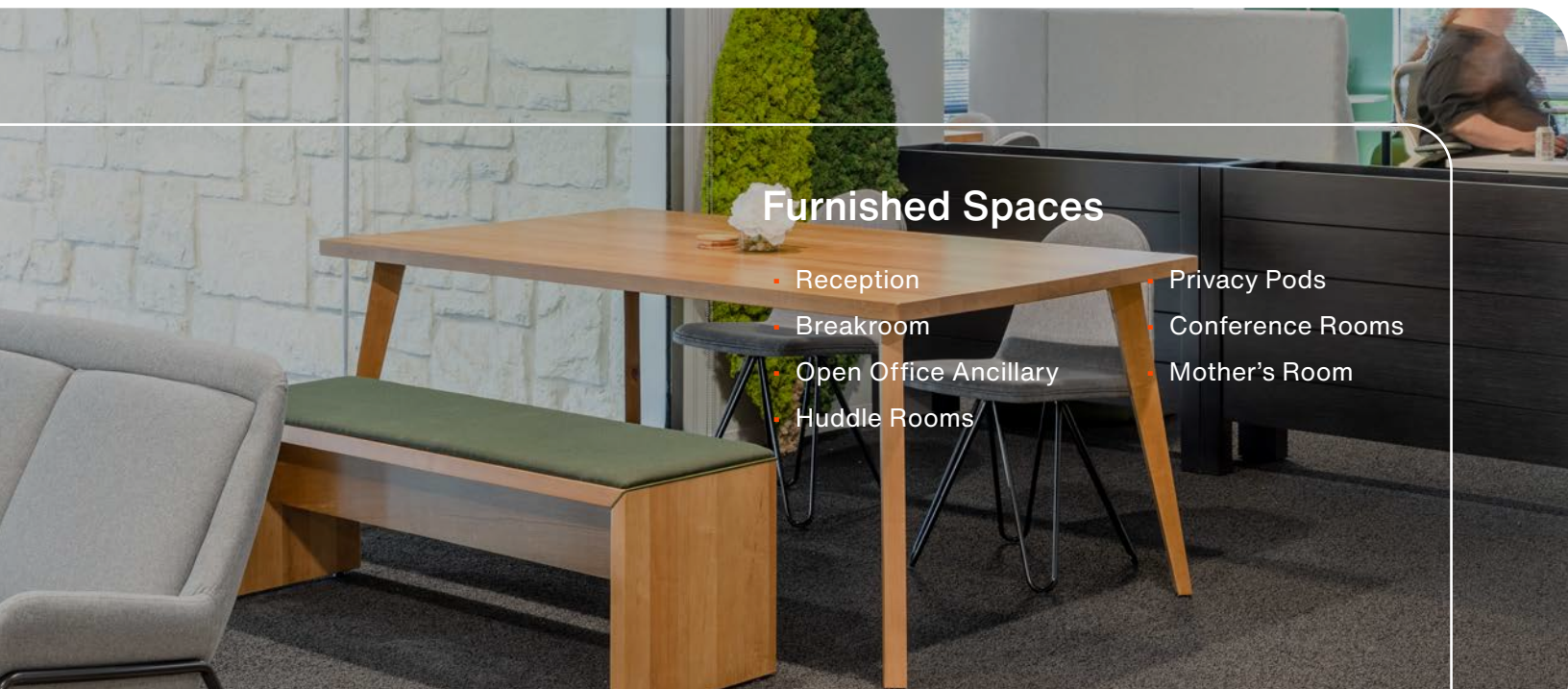
The Challenge
