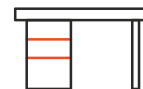

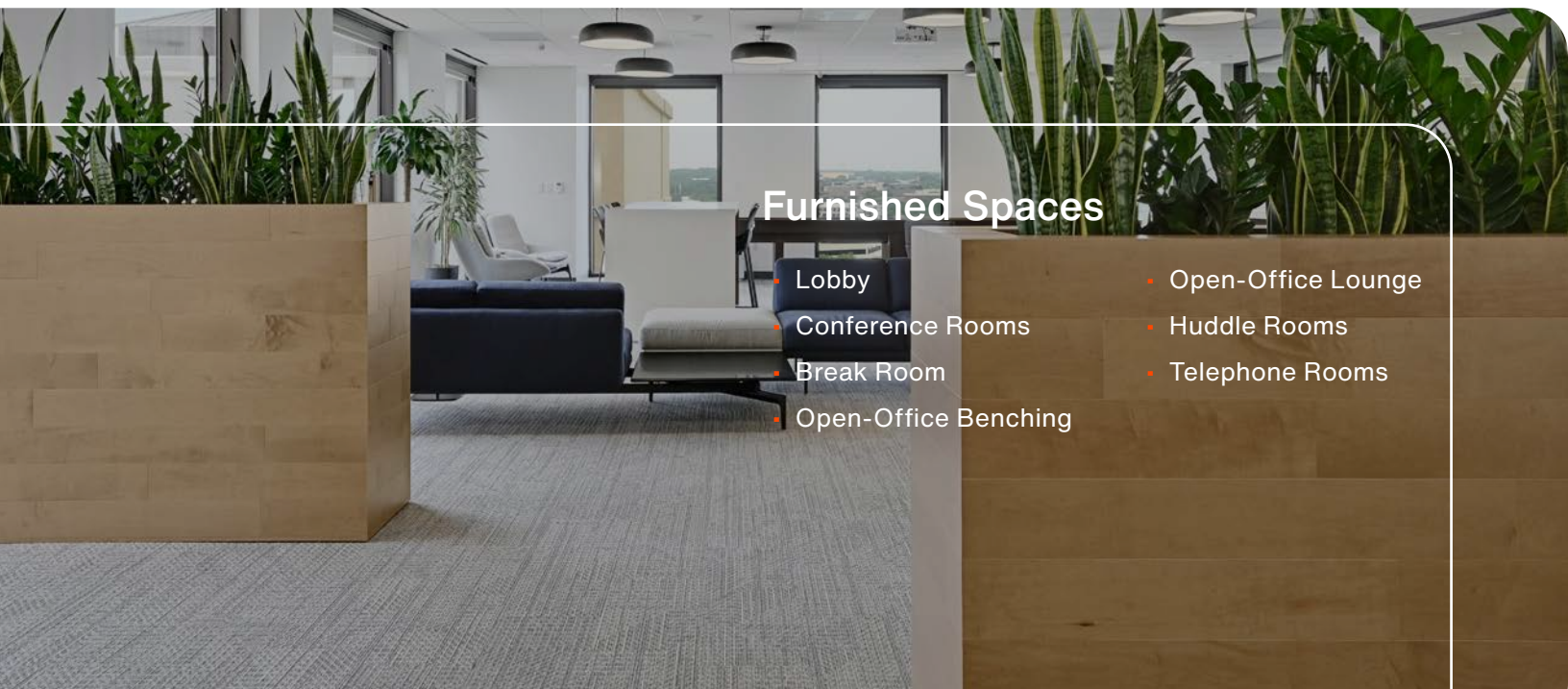
The Challenge

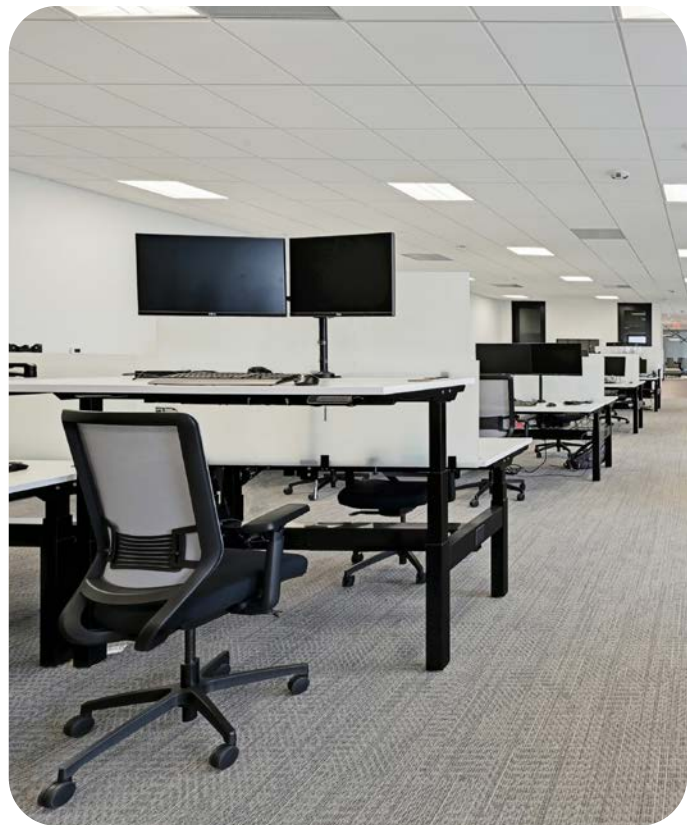


Project Summary

We strategically selected options that would check each of these boxes and meet the design requirements to fulfill the vision of the space without exceeding the budget.

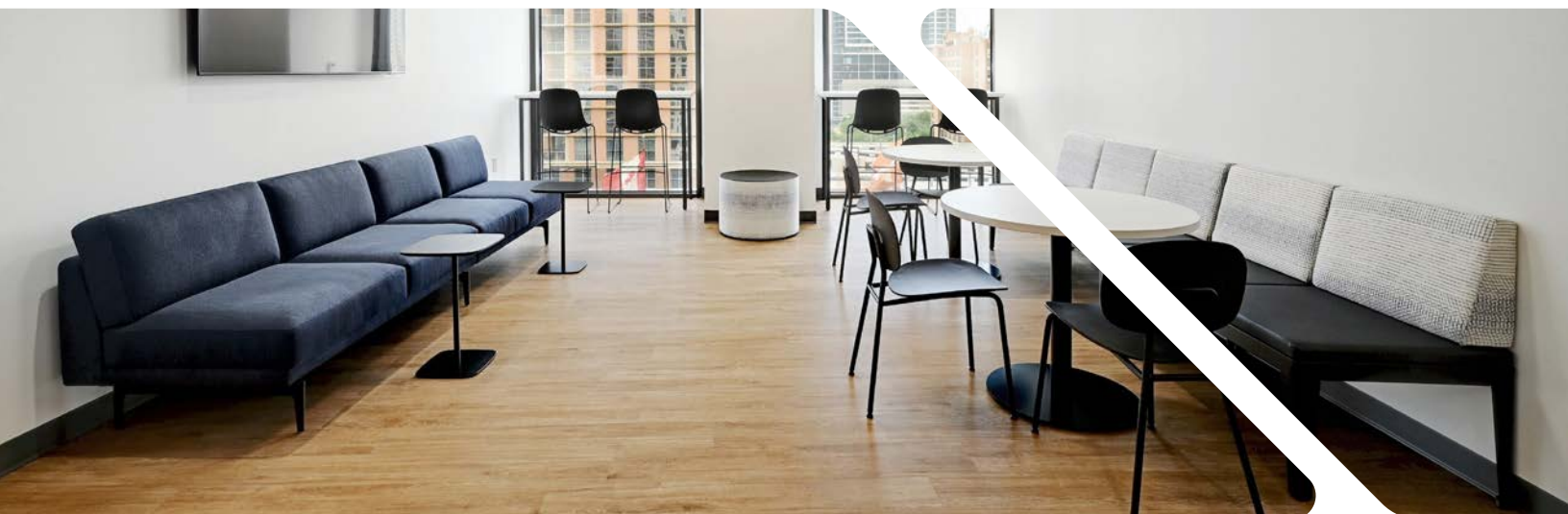
To maximize collaboration, the client opted to use rows of benching systems using a hot-desking layout. This layout allows everyone to connect with different team members on a regular basis. The space also features eight conference and meeting rooms that can be used to connect internally or meet with external partners and investors.

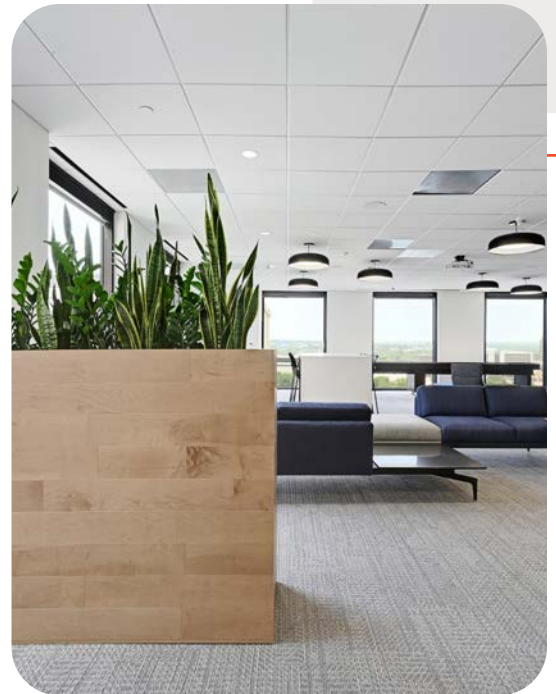
